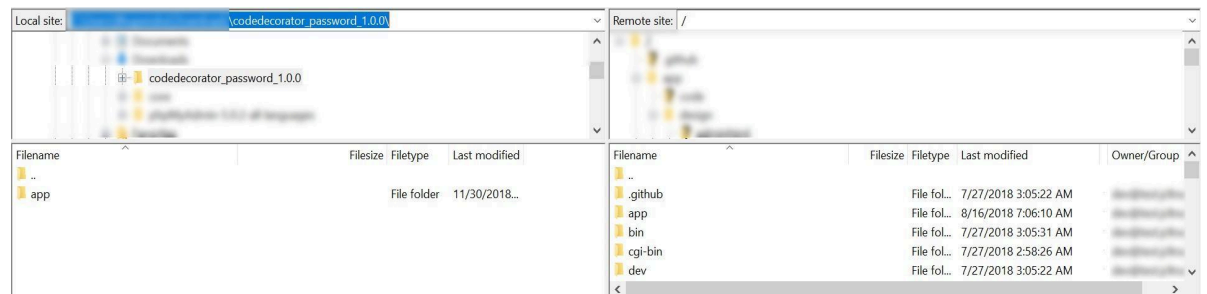
## Introduction

Magento 2 Discount Per Customer Extension by CodeDecorator is helpful to attract more customers to your store and increase business loyalty. Store owners get the liberty to set discount percentages (%) of customers, which is a great opportunity for admin to earn loyalty and long-term relationships.

## Installation Steps

### 1. Upload Extension Folder

- Get an extension from our extension store or marketplace.
- Unzip the extension and upload the folder structure to your store root directory like the following image



### 2. Install and Activate the Module

Login to your SSH server and go to your root directory of Magento2 installation. Enter the following commands via SSH using putty or others.

**php bin/magento setup:upgrade**

following is the example:

```
:/var/www/html$ php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

## Deactivation Steps

### 1. Deactivate using SSH (Command Line)

Login to your SSH server and go to your root directory of Magento2 installation. Enter the following commands via SSH using Putty or others.

```
php bin/magento module:disable Codedecorator_Core
```

```
php bin/magento module:disable Codedecorator_CustomerDiscount
```

### 2. Flush the cache

You can flush the cache from the admin or you can do it using the following command in SSH login.

```
php bin/magento cache:clean
```

## Remove Module Steps

### 1. Deactivate using SSH (Command Line)

Login to your SSH server and go to your root directory of Magento2 installation. Enter the following commands via SSH using Putty or others.

```
php bin/magento module:disable Codedecorator_Core
```

```
php bin/magento module:disable Codedecorator_CustomerDiscount
```

### 2. Remove the module directory

Remove the module directory using the FTP manager and delete the director available on the following directory path

<Magento2 Root Director>/app/code/Codedecorator/ It should look like the following

### 3. Flush the cache

You can flush the cache from the admin or you can do it using the following command in SSH login.

**php bin/magento cache:clean**
